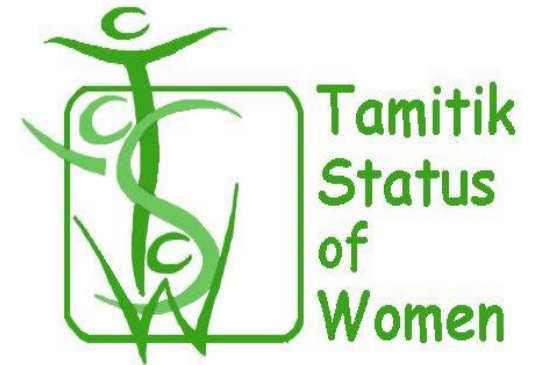

◆ *Baby's Needs*

This program provides a selection of products such as, diapers, formula, and baby wipes to low income families on an emergency need basis or monthly as needed.

A variety of programs and events are offered periodically throughout the year, such as back to school, children and family activities.

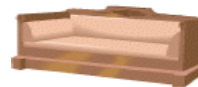
Programs
